INTRODUCTION

The Balochistan Charities Registration & Regulation Authority-BCRA Act 2019 has been passed by the Provincial Assembly (Balochistan) to provide legal cover, substitute and consolidate the Laws for registration, regulation and facilitation of Charities in Balochistan

BCRA does not only registrar the NPOs /NGO but also facilitate in regulation & assistance which reveals the importance and status of charities in the society. Apart from the assistance & facilitation provisions, Combatting terrorist financing is top priority for the FATF, and a key part of the FATF's objectives in strengthening financial sector integrity and contributing to safety and security therefore Baluchistan Charities Registration & Regulation Authority –BCRA has developed a registration online mechanism to Observe/Monitor that the Funds are not utilized for terror activities & further the funds are fully utilized for best need & interest of the Public, in this regard annual financial audit report for all NGOs/NPOs is essential to be shared with BCRA.

The Balochistan Charities Registration & Regulation Authority team on, 8th November 2021 held a meeting with the representatives of different NPOs, the Directors of BCRA briefed the participants about BCRA and its ACT, it was said that registration with BCRA is essential for all NPOs. He further explained that how BCRA has eased the registration process for NPOs/NGOs, the NPOs now can easily apply for online registration from any part of the province. Meanwhile the Orientation Session on the online registration Procedure of BCRA also was conducted. In this regard, Mr. Muhammad Umar Akbar, IT Officer, gave brief details regarding procedures of online registration with BCRA. All the participants were provided information & guidelines, applying for the online registration one by one with sample entries for understanding the registration procedure. Upon the questions regarding registration from participants, they were, replied with satisfaction. The representatives further assist; provide guidelines and assistance for online registration so the issues at the district level will be solved



During the Briefing Session, the Director District Coordinators, Mr. Nazar Muhammad Khetran, reiterated that well mobilized and empowered NGO/NPOs can trigger and enhance local level development especially in times of emergencies or catastrophe, these organizations greatly enhanced the host outreach of Government Relief Agencies. NGO/NPOs are also supporting Government of Balochistan district administrations and line departments' routine outreach, e.g. coverage of POLIO vaccinations, COVID-19 vaccinations, enrolment campaigns of the education department, etc.

The Properly mobilized NGO/CBO/LSO/CI/NGO/NPOs play a vital role in the development of the rural areas and uplift of the standard of life of rural communities, which are deprived of the basic facilities and minimum infrastructure. This shared understanding forms the basis and rationale to formally REGISTER these CBO/NGO/LSO and thereby ensure that NGO/CBO/LSO become institutionalized partners in the GoB Local Government systems.

The Balochistan Charities Registration & Regulation Authority-BCRA officials conducted a meeting with Mr. Ahmed Khan, the Social Welfare officer-Pishin on the same day in the social welfare office-Pishin. Girls (15-19) will follow a fast-track Basic Literacy Numeracy course (BLN) and Financial literacy training then will transition into a livelihood’s skills and vocational training program and further technical training, employment, and self-employment.

5. Visit to Red Crescent field Office Killa Abdullah



- During Physical Inspection it was observed that the office of Organization was well established, and the staff was working properly.

3. Visit to Aware Organziation

The director of the registration strictly suggest them to be registered with BCRA or else the activities will not be allowed to continue as all the previous laws of registration are repealed and the registrations of NPOs will be through BCRA Act 2019. The Organization assured BCRA officials regarding registration of the Organization with BCRA.



The Balochistan Charities Registration & Regulation Authority BCRA Officials just after the Orientation, visited NRSP Office at Kech and met with Mr. Nabeel Baloch, he welcomed the Team and appreciated the work of BCRA. He told BCRA about their currently going projects and the funding they have to provide to all LSOs, VO's Further; he added that the



Organization will ensure to register all of LSOs, VOs with BCRA very soon.



He also said that he will share the list of the LSOs VOs with BRSP and requested for the documentation of Zakat from the government given to LSO for Ramadan. The director registration noted the issue and told that the matter will be taken to concerned

iii) Visit to Library (Balochistan Academy)

The Balochistan Charities Registration & Regulation Authority BCRA Officer on the same day went and visited the office premises of a library namely, Balochistan Academy. The chairman warmly welcomed the BCRA team and briefed his library activities; he said that the Academy is particularly working in Balochistan and especially in district Kech.



During the meeting the team discussed on various topics such as to promote curriculum books and to promote educational, research, culture recreational and informational requirements of students, teachers, researchers and general users.

The Director Registration, Mr. Abdul Fateh appreciated the efforts of the Academy and assured the academy for any assistance in future.



Services of Registration Facilitation Centre;

The BCRA established Registration Facilitation Centers in all 9-BRACE districts are committed to facilitating the NPOs/NGOs during the filling of forms/floating applications via online and submission to BCRA, for issuance of registration certificates., and the RFC staff support NPOs/NGOs in:

- Providing access to use of computer and internet facility.
- Uploading of NPOs/NGOs request for registration online.
- Guiding NPOs to fulfill criteria set by BCRA.
- Attaching/scanning the relevant documents along with application/request for registration.
- Follow up with BCRA on the application submitted online.
- Making orientation of the members of NPOs/NGOs on the process of registration of Cls.
- Clarification against queries raised by the BCRA during follow-up of the registration case of NPO.
- Support NPOs in the preparation of an affidavit regarding the works/activities of the organization in accordance with the Balochistan Charities Registration, Regulation, and Facilitation Act. XI of 2019.
- The Mechanism for the redressed of complaints against the staff of the RFCs is missing at district level.
- Guidance on the Audit mechanism.

Observations;

During visits following observations were pointed out;

- The NPOs/NGOs are still facing problems regarding online registration.
- Many NPOs/NGOs are unaware about BCRA-ACT 2019 for registration with BCRA
- Unavailability of Network in several areas/districts of Balochistan
- The Option of Union Council/New Tehsils of Balochistan Province in WEB portal of BCRA for convincing direct address of NPOs/NGOs
- Organizations missing in search Charity page
- Admin Panel of Waqf Trust properties.
- Change the Name of Prohibited Names of Organizations in Web-Page.
- Report Generation District wise.

Findings;

- Large number of representatives from NPOs/NGOs/Local Government/Social Welfare Department and BRACE TA attended the orientation sessions.
- The level of the interest of members of NPOs/NGOs was very good and participants took interest in knowing the processes involved in the registration of CIs.
- While the NPO/NGO were found very active and know the key problems/needs of their own village/UC, they require capacity building, as most local CBO/NGO did not know the basics of a coherent Community Mobilization/Community Empowerment approach.
- No representative/staff hired/posted by BCRA at the district level but RFCs have been established in all districts.
- The staff of RFCs is not specifically working for registration of NPO/NGO and they are also doing additional tasks along with their regular assignments in their parent Organizations.
- NPOs/NGOs are facing the issue of Bank Accounts opening in the local banks at the district level.
- Most of the members of NPOs/NGOs are illiterate and lacking in IT skills.
- The Female staff of NPOs/NGOs has little access to RFCs in most of the districts except Kech because the female staff has not been placed at the strength of the RFCs which is causing the lack of interaction with female members of NPOs.
- The mechanism of CB and regular guidance and visits of RFC staff is required.
- The BCR&RA has no set up at the district level which could guide the NPOs/RFCs in registration/renewal.
- The district staff of Social Welfare Offices needs to be linked with BCRA office.
- The Regular visits of BCR&RA staff to district NPOs/NGOs are insufficient.
- The establishment of RFC in all district is needed.

RECOMMENDATIONS;

- The most immediate issue being faced to NPO's NGO's during visits/ Orientation sessions, opening of Bank Accounts to registered entities which requires special attention to be discussed with concerned Stake-Holders for its settlements. The Audit of all NPO's NGO's are urgently required to regulate/monitor the social sector in order to achieve the Targets & Assignments of MOI, NACTA & FATF.
- BCRA took issues/hurdles of NPOs/NGOs during registration/Renewal/with Authorities to be resolved with relevant authorities/staff at District and Provincial level is the most important matter to be resolved immediately.
- NPOs/NGOs & RFC to follow the checklist issued by BCRA for registration of NPOs/NGOs during uploading the registration request.
- NPOs/NGOs to deposit registration fee according to the approved fee structure of BCRA.

- BCRA to develop a mechanism for the readdress of complaints against the staff of the RFCs.
- BCRA make available record of NPOs/CIs registrations at the district level for the facilitation of district stakeholders.
- BCRA to establish RFCs in remaining district.
- A female member in RFC may be nominated for female members of NPOs/NGOs to ease the access of females working in NPO sector to these centers for Registration.
- Coordination between staff of RFC and district administration/ line departments (especially SWD)/NPOs and BCRA is required to be strengthened more.
- Extension of full Cooperation/coordination to BCRA through Facilitation Centers in Districts for Online registration process.
- The capacity building of Social Welfare Department officers & officials, & NPOs, LSOs, VO, representatives is urgently required to understand the latest mechanism.
- Conduction of trainings on proposal writing for the small and medium level NPOs.
- Improve linkages of the small and medium level NPOs with donors.
- Appropriate measures may be taken to streamline Registration Process.
